



Chatfield Junior Regatta July 22, 2017

Notice of Race

You're invited to race in the CSYC Chatfield Junior Regatta on July 22, 2017 at Chatfield Reservoir in the Roxborough Cove. You will need to bring a boat to race although CSYC has several loaner boats available on a first-come basis if you need a boat.

1. **Rules:** The *2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing* will govern these Races. Sailing instructions and the *Boating Regulations of Colorado Parks and Wildlife* may modify the rules as permitted.
2. **Eligibility and Entry:** There will be a juniors-only fleet for those who have not reached their 19th birthday by January 1, 2017, and an adult/junior fleet with an adult plus juniors on board. Adult racers must have at least one junior on board to compete.

Eligible boats are single-handed and double-handed monohull dinghies. Each boat must display sail numbers.

Entry may be made by completing and submitting the registration form with parental consent and paying the entry fee of \$5.00 (includes lunch). All juniors must have the parental permission section of the registration form completed and signed by a parent or guardian no later than 9:45 AM on July 22nd at registration.

The Race Committee will determine classes/fleets.

3. **Notice to Competitors:** Notices will be posted on the bulletin board located in front of the registration tent.
4. **Signals Made Ashore:** Signals will be made in front of the Registration tent.
5. **Schedule:**

Registration starts at 8:30 AM at Roxborough Cove which is east of the Marina and the South Ramp. Sailing instructions will be given to competitors at Registration.

The competitors meeting will be held at 9:15 am to announce fleets and starting order. There will be several races with the first to start about 10:00 am. There will be a lunch break with more racing after lunch. No race will be started after 2:00 pm. Awards will be presented after racing.

Sailing Instructions will be distributed at registration and will be posted by July 3rd on the **Colorado Sail and Yacht Club** web site <http://www.csyc.org>

6. **Scoring System:** Races will be finished using the Portsmouth Handicap. Scoring will be by the low-point system, Appendix A2.

7. **Prizes:** Trophies will be awarded based on number of competitors in each class.

Scores will count toward the SAIL Tour Junior Trophy for 2017 provided the junior racer is a member of SAIL.
