## NOTICE OF RACE

1. **THE REGATTA:** The Colorado Sail and Yacht Club (CSYC), as Organizing Authority, will conduct its Autumn Winds Regatta on September 23, 2017.
2. **RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the rules defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRs) 2017-2020, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions for this Regatta and the Class Rules for all One Design Fleets racing.
  - 2.1 Racing Rules Appendix A is modified by Item 9, Scoring.
  - 2.2 The Sailing Instructions may also change other rules.
3. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**
  - 3.1 The Autumn Winds Regatta will be a one-day event raced. Event is open to Keel, Dinghy and Multi-hull fleets.
  - 3.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completion of the attached Autumn Winds Regatta entry form and sending it, with the required fees, to the address shown at the bottom of this document. In addition, registration and payment can be made at [www.csync.org](http://www.csync.org) after August 25, 2017. Late registration can be completed at the picnic pavilion south of the marina parking lot on September 23rd, 2017, before registration closes.
  - 3.3 Fleet status will be given to groups of three or more One-Design boats. At least one PHRF and one Portsmouth class is anticipated. Additional handicap fleets will be established at the discretion of the Race Director.
  - 3.4 Eligibility requirements for boats include that they be currently registered in their state of origin, display their current registration and have paid their entry fees. Boats not registered or who have not paid the entry fee will not be considered competitors.
  - 3.5 Boats racing in the PHRF Fleet must have a current Sailing Association of Intermountain Lakes (SAIL) PHRF certificate. Both annual Certificates (SAIL Membership \$15.00 and PHRF Certificates \$5.00) and temporary regatta certificates can be purchased during check-in.
4. **FEES:** Entry may be made by completing and signing the Autumn Winds Regatta Entry Form, paying the entry fee specified and mailing the form and payment to the address given. Late entry may be made at the time of registration. The organizers retain the right to reject entries.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available on the CSYC website ([www.csyc.org](http://www.csyc.org)) and during onsite regatta registration.
7. VENUE:
- 7.1 The Event will be held on Chatfield Reservoir in Chatfield State Park.
  - 7.2 Non-racing activities including registration and skippers meeting will be held at the Riverside Pavilion across the parking lot from the marina.
  - 7.3 Use of the south boat ramps and parking is recommended.
  - 7.4 Guest slips are available at Chatfield Marina for September 22 & 23, Contact the Marina Office (303-791-5555) for additional information and reservations.
  - 7.5 Appendix A shows Chatfield Reservoir and the approximate location of the fixed race marks.
8. COURSES: Movable and fixed marks will be used to sail courses based on Windward/Leeward and Triangular configurations.
9. SCORING: A minimum of one race will make the regatta. Races will be scored and ties broken using the Low-point Scoring System, Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing. There will be no throw-outs; this modifies A2.
10. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS: The Race Committee may hail starting sequences and identification of boats not complying with rule 29.1 by VHF on Channel 68. Failure to hail, to hear a hail, or order of hails shall not be grounds for regress. Competitors may NOT hail the Race Committee to check in. The Race Committee will not respond to hail during a starting sequence or race, except to acknowledge protest, retirement or emergencies.
11. TROPHIES: Fleets with three boats will be awarded a first place trophy only. Fleets with four boats will be awarded a first and second place trophy. Fleets with greater than five boats will a first, second and third place trophy.
12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

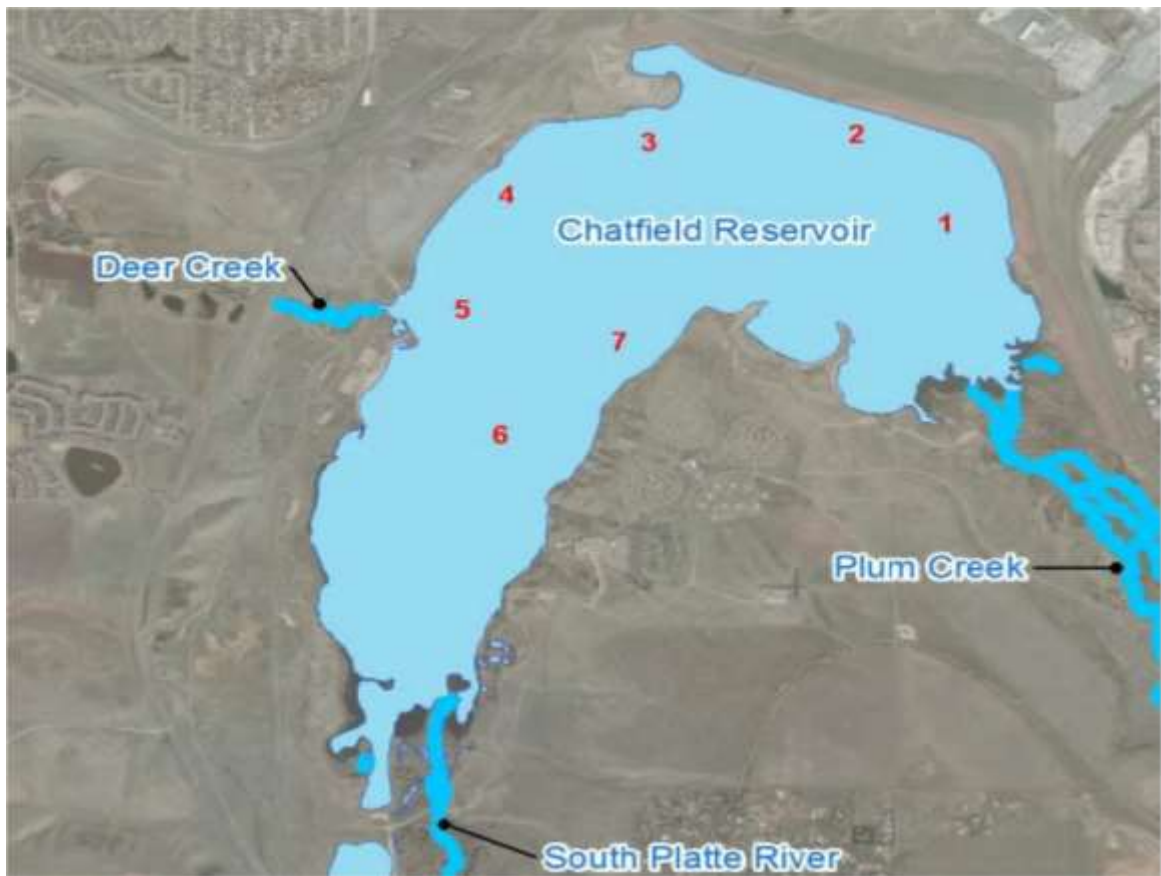
