



# CSYC FUGAWE – August 5, 2023

Here are our very informal rules for the Fugawe. The Racing Rules of Sailing cover everything not mentioned here. The cost is **\$20.00 per boat**, collected at the raft-up before the race.

1. Raft up near **Mark 6** at 6:00 p.m. Rules and time sheets will be passed out there.
2. **Sunset is 8:08 p.m.** At approximately 7:50 p.m. the rafted-up boats will separate.
3. Every boat **must anchor** somewhere south of the no wake buoys.
4. Boats must be **anchored with all sails down or furled**. Headsails hanked or boltroped on must be down on the deck. Mainsails can be bent on but must be down on the boom.
5. **All crew must go below at 8:07 p.m.** Two short horn blasts will signal all to go below.
6. **The starting horn will sound at 8:08 p.m.** When the starting horn sounds, crew can come up, weigh anchor, hoist sails, and start racing. **Boats may not use auxiliary power to weigh anchor or get underway.**
7. **Two no wake buoys will be designated as a starting gate. Boats must pass through the starting gate and sail to Mark 7 as the first mark.** After passing Mark 7 for the first time, skippers choose the course to sail.
8. **Only Marks 2, 5 and 7 will be used, and they will be lighted.** All marks must be left to port on roundings.
9. **Boats may choose their course, except they may not round the same pair of marks more than twice in a row.** For example, you can round Mark 5, then Mark 7, then Mark 5 again, then Mark 7 again, but after that you must round Mark 2 before going back to either Mark 5 or Mark 7.
10. **Each boat's last mark rounding must be before 12:00 a.m. Then each boat must finish through a gate comprised of the red and green marina channel markers.**
11. **If a boat finishes early, its finish time will be adjusted to 12:00 a.m.,** otherwise the actual time at which it passed through the finish gate will be used. Please record finish times including the number of seconds within the minute, or 59 seconds will be used.
12. **All boats must comply with the U.S. Inland Navigation Rules on lighting (Part C at <https://www.navcen.uscg.gov/navigation-rules-amalgamated>).**
13. **Boats must have VHF radios using Channel 68.**

Boats must record the time at which they round each mark, in order, on the attached time sheet using 24-hour clock notation. **Time recording is on an honor system.** Minute precision is sufficient for mark roundings, but the finish time should be recorded with second precision.

All boats shall check in with Grenadine at the raft-up and **notify Grenadine on VHF Channel 68 if retiring early.** Any other race-related matters should be raised to Grenadine on VHF 68.

After the race, please give time sheets to Grenadine (Randy Stafford) before leaving the lake. If you do not see him, send a photo of your time sheet to [scorer@csyc.org](mailto:scorer@csyc.org). The club's scorer will calculate for each boat the total distance traveled, and the time required to travel that distance adjusted by PHRF rating – thus each boat's PHRF-adjusted average speed. The fastest average speed determines the winner.

*This a fun race under different conditions than series races and regattas. The intent is to have a very social race. If two boats get close, please give way. Be safe and be smart.*
